Dear parents, carers, boys & girls,

An extremely important newsletter this week for all boys and girls in year 5 2017 and their very supportive parents.

Dear Year 5 boys and girls,

I am inviting you to consider standing for a position on the 2018 LEADERSHIP TEAM.

All year 5 students are invited to campaign for a position on the 2018 Leadership Team. There are two tiers to our leadership team; the school captaincy and sporting leaders.

First The School Leadership Team. Each year students campaign for the position of Girls' Captain and Boys' Captain. As a result of the voting process the student with the most votes becomes the captain, the next highest the Vice Captain and the next places, the prefects.

There are four elements to the campaign.

- 1. <u>Prepare an information poster</u> for display in the school. This poster should include a photo, for identification purposes; your name and any information which you believe will encourage students to vote for you.
- 2. You must have a long record of being a SAFE, RESPECTFUL LEARNER in the classroom, the playground and in all aspects of life. (An occasional reflection room session is OK as we all learn from mistakes made in life.)
- 3. **Prepare a 2-3 minute speech** which outlines your leadership aspirations.
- 4. Make a commitment to being the best person you can be during the election process. This means being a <u>SAFE</u>, <u>RESPECTFUL LEARNER</u>. No promises that you cannot keep. No lollies, no gifts, no vote buying with the students or staff. Just good old fashioned manners, helpfulness, kindness to others, a kind word here or there with the younger students, but most importantly be yourself.

Please bring your **poster** to Mrs Bunga for tools to pin, tape, hang, to be displayed on mobile boards from **Monday 20th November.** If you are ready earlier, just bring in your poster.

Election speeches to staff, Year 5 parents and students will be delivered on *Wednesday* 6 December; with the young ladies presenting from 9.30am until finished. Followed the young gentlemen from 12 noon.

Secondly, the Sporting Leadership Team. This team is selected via a less formal process at Sporting House Meetings. These elections will be held on Wednesday 6 December from 2pm in various locations around the school. Our current year 5 students are able to stand for 2018 the Captaincy position; while 2017 year 4 students are given the opportunity to be vice Captains. There are four sports teams; which are Avon, Cordeaux, Nepean and Warragamba.

<u>Season of Giving</u> Four Yr 6 students Zak O, Zac M, Laith B and Levi E have presented their business plan to Mrs Bunga. <u>The boys would like to support the Salvation Army Xmas Appeal</u>.
