Bargo PS Kids are Safe Respectful Learners

Dear parents, carers, boys & girls,

The main topic for this week's newsletter is bike safety!

Does your child know the road rule?

Sadly, we have had a number of near misses over the last fortnight. Toddlers and elderly have been hit by BPS students in uniform traveling to and from school on their bike or scooter.

Mums and dads, boys and girls, bike riders do not own the footpath, pedestrians do. So if you are riding a bike or scooter near people on the footpath, it is your job to slow down and pass carefully. It is not your job to scream out ... 'Coming through. Get out of the way!'

Sadly we have a number of students who ride their bike over the overpass, instead of dismounting and walking over.

Again, bike riders do not own the overpass, pedestrians do. So if you are riding a bike or scooter and you need to use the overpass at the railway station it is your job to dismount and walk over.

Sadly, children are riding down the centre of the street, weaving between traffic, bolting out across the pedestrian crossing without looking.

Also while on safe travelling to and from school, it is very dangerous to be walking down the middle of the road. It has been reported that some children are doing this on Hawthorne Road.

Again, mums and dads please chat with your children about bike safety and their responsibilities while riding on the road, moving between parked car and the reaction time it takes to stop a car travelling at 80 kilometres at hour when a bike rider flashes out from the side of the road.

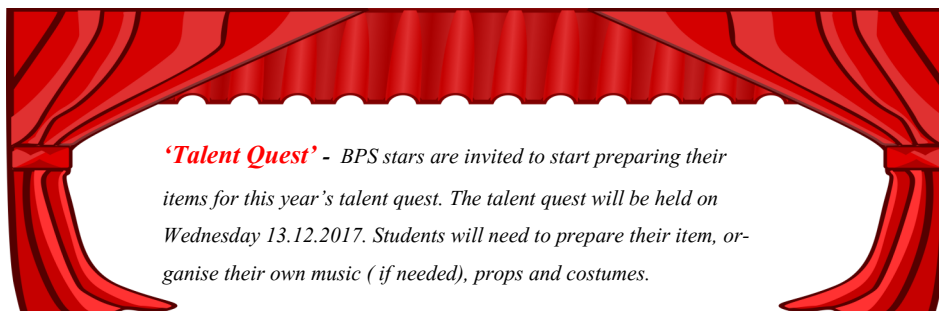
